
Index of turnover in industry

2010, June

Turnover in manufacturing grew by good 9 per cent in April to June from the year before

According to Statistics Finland, in the April to June period of 2010 turnover in manufacturing was 9.6 per cent higher than in the corresponding period of the year before. Domestic sales grew by 10.1 per cent and export turnover by 9.4 per cent from one year ago.

Turnover went up from the corresponding period of the previous year in nearly all sub-industries. The strongest growths were recorded in water supply, sewerage and waste management (34.6%), in the forest industry (32.9%) and in mining and quarrying (31.6%). In contrast, the declines were steepest in the electronic and electrical industry (-3.7%) and in the food industry (-2.5%).

The index of turnover in industry describes enterprises whose main industry is manufacturing. The calculation of the indices is based on the Tax Administration's value added tax data which are supplemented with data obtained with Statistics Finland's sales inquiry. The monthly turnovers of manufacturing enterprises can vary considerably, especially in the metal industries. The variation is mainly due to invoicing practices. The final invoice for major machinery deliveries and projects may be recorded in the sales of one month, even if the delivery had required the work of several months or years.











Appendix figure 1. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in manufacturing 1/1995–6/2010


Appendix figure 2. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in the forest industry 1/1995–6/2010
